Acceptable Use Policy

Saint David's School provides its students with the opportunity to use a networked computer system for educational purposes. As part of the school's curriculum, students may also access the Internet and school email for academic research and communication. The use of these computer resources is a privilege; users are expected to use these resources appropriately, responsibly, legally, and ethically. Student access to school computers and network resources is for educational purposes only. Failure to comply with the regulations below (and any other regulations promulgated by the school) may result in the suspension of computer privileges in addition to serious disciplinary action. The Acceptable Use Policy is in effect for all years a student is at Saint David's School.

THE FOLLOWING CONSTITUTE UNACCEPTABLE USE:

- Using another person's password
 - Trespassing in another person's account
 - Copying software from school computers
 - Installing software on school computers
 - Attempting to damage computer equipment or attempting to alter internal settings
 - Sending or displaying offensive, harassing, or obscene material
 - Posting defamatory comments about a person in an online public forum.
 - Attempting to access offensive or obscene websites or websites that have no bearing on the educational mission of the school
 - Failing to inform a teacher of any message that a student receives that is inappropriate or makes him feel uncomfortable
 - Plagiarizing (taking ideas or writing from another person and saying it is one's own)
 - Giving out personal information about yourself to others online (i.e., home address, telephone number, or credit card number)
 - Using Saint David's technology resources for commercial purposes
